Minutes of the Extraordinary Parish Council meeting on 23rd June 2021 7pm at the Long Compton Village Hall

3. Public Forum:

4. Quarry Planning Applications:
Cllr Bing opened the meeting explaining although there are two agenda items, they will merge in to one during points of the discussion
Disappointingly we have had no response to our invitations to Warwickshire Highways, Warwickshire Road Safety or the Oxford County Councillor.
All three planning applications have been issued with the same objection from the Parish Council.

District Cllr Whalley-Hoggins and County Councillor Barker said we needed to wait until after Friday to see what happens. We have done all we can at this point.

Physical evidence and traffic surveys were discussed

Weight limit signs were discussed and Cllr Barker asked to press Highways on this. Barker to press on the environmental need for these in regards to Dust, pollution and ANOB.

A member of the public asked if residents objections were even taken in to consideration. Cllr Bing noted that there was no representative from Oxfordshire present to comment on this, but pointed out that as a 3rd party consultee, our responses are noted, but not always considered.

Everything that everybody has done has slowed down the application process hence why it is still going on.
